

**Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program
Agreement with
The [REDACTED] Housing Authority**

The Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program is a division of the Alameda County Community Development Agency.

The [REDACTED] Housing Authority will contract with the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, a program with expertise in Healthy Homes interventions, for the following deliverables at the rate designated below for each unit referred by the [REDACTED] Housing Authority:

<u>Activity</u>	<u>Rate</u>
• Visual assessments	\$167 per visit
• A Healthy Homes Summary report	\$111 each
• An environmental treatment (basic)	\$350 each
• In-home education to tenants for housing-related health issues and maintaining a Healthy Home.	
○ Initial visit	\$164 per visit
○ 30 day follow up visit	\$109 per visit
○ 3-month follow up visit	\$109 per visit
• Provide a Healthy Homes Maintenance Kit	\$105 each

The Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program will provide training to [REDACTED] HA at the following rates:

- Training sessions for [REDACTED] HA personnel on Healthy Homes concepts and interventions \$125 per hour
- Provide technical assistance \$111 per hour

The [REDACTED] Housing Authority will provide the Alameda County Lead Poisoning Prevention Program:

- A minimum of three business days advance notice for service requests and requests for technical assistance
- Completed referral forms outlining unusual circumstances
- Payment within 30 days of invoice receipt

Any disagreement between the [REDACTED] HA and ACLPPP will be resolved in a timely manner so as not to disrupt service delivery. Any issue pertaining to the provision of services will be directed to the attention of the [REDACTED] HA Manager assigned to oversee the services provided by the ACLPPP. The [REDACTED] HA Manager will contact the ACLPPP Environmental Services Manager and if the issue cannot be resolved within 10 business days the [REDACTED] HA Manager will direct the issue to the Director, ACLPPP. If the ACLPPP Director is unable to resolve the dispute within 10 business days, the matter will then be referred to the Director of [REDACTED] HA for resolution.

The term of this agreement is August 1, 2008 through July 31, 2010. This agreement may be cancelled by either party with 10 days written notification.
