




CRITICAL DETAIL: FOUNDATION WALL SEALING


ENERGY + HEALTH PROGRAM

1. Find penetrations through foundation walls. Look for sewer pipes, water supply lines, drain pipes, electrical wiring, etc. Do not seal weep holes.
2. For holes 1/4 in. or less, seal with water-proof polyurethane or silicone caulk.
3. For holes 1/4 in. to 3/4 in., install backer rod and copper mesh. Seal with water-proof polyurethane caulk or silicone.
4. For holes greater than 3/4 in., mix a small batch of hydraulic cement by hand and use to seal penetrations.


✓ LOCATE HOLES
