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In response to the water contamination Flint, Michigan, the State of Michigan specifically asked CDC to:

- 1. Coordinate health messaging**
- 2. Provide guidance on blood lead screening protocols**
- 3. Identify and link community members to case management**
- 4. Assess chemical exposure on the community**
