Based on the submitted material this course has been found to meet all of the criteria for approval as specified in Chapters 3701-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).

O.A.C. 3701-32-16.2 (A)(3)(c) requires you to submit a training program prior notification to ODH of the scheduled training courses at least ten business days, or three business days if using the online notification system, prior to the commencement of any approved training course. If there is any change training program notification that would render the information on the notification no longer accurate you are required to submit a revised training program prior notification.

This approval may be revoked by the Director of Health for violating the requirements of O.A.C Chapters 3701-32.
